

Inclement Weather Procedures

Purpose

9.16-1

The purpose of this policy is to establish criteria and guidelines for students who are required to travel from one building to an outside building during inclement weather. (See AD 10.64) Only under extreme weather conditions will classes not be held. In the event that unit administration determine that inclement weather conditions prevent students from moving outside from one building to another building, the following guidelines will apply:

Emergency Lesson Plans

9.16-2

The principal will have all teachers prepare emergency lesson plans that are on file in the principal's office.

Locations To Conduct Class During Inclement Weather

9.16-3

The principal and unit warden will determine prearranged locations where classes may be held during inclement weather. During inclement weather conditions, the instructors and students will participate in class at the prearranged locations using the emergency lesson plans. When unit administration determines that inclement weather conditions no longer exist, the student and teachers will go to the appropriate shops or classrooms.

Appropriate Clothing

9.16-4

Inclement weather conditions may be a result of cold temperature. When students must travel from one location to another during cold weather, appropriate clothing will be issued by the unit clothing department to all students. Raingear will not be issued to students.
